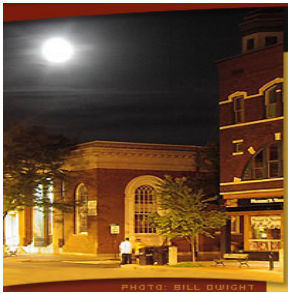


# Shopping Itinerary Pioneer Valley of Massachusetts

## Day One

Depart Amsterdam at 1:30 p.m. and arrive at Bradley International Airport at 3:30 p.m.

Breeze through Bradley's quick and easy customs and immigration and choose from Alamo, Avis, Budget, Enterprise or Hertz car rentals, to travel with ease throughout New England. Once you pick up your rental car, you have a variety of hotels to choose from. If you're feeling up to the short 25 minute drive, travel to Northampton to enjoy a bit of shopping before dinner. Recently voted the "Best Small Arts Town in North America," take in Northampton by strolling down the quaint streets and browsing the Thornes Marketplace. Thornes, in the heart of downtown Northampton, is a restored old-world department store with four floors of one-of-a-kind specialty shops including clothing, home furnishings, restaurants, galleries, crafts and toys for all ages. After a bit of shopping, head to the Eastside Grill for a delicious dinner. The Eastside Grill, located conveniently in downtown Northampton, has served robustly flavored, seasonal American cuisine in a relaxed and casual setting since 1985. After dinner drive back to the Marriott and rest up for the following day.

Or, stay in Springfield and enjoy dinner at Pazzo Ristorante, a charming yet chic Italian restaurant, offering live entertainment and dancing on Fridays.

## Day Two



Prime Outlets, Lee

Enjoy breakfast at Current's Restaurant, at the Marriott, and then head northwest to the Prime Outlets in Lee, MA. At Lee, you will find Tommy Hilfiger, COACH, BCBGMAXAZRIA, Calvin Klein, Polo Ralph Lauren and many more outlets. Grab a quick bite in the food court, conveniently located at the Lee Outlets.

Continue north to North Adams, home of Mass MoCA, just an hour away from Lee. Mass MoCA is the largest contemporary art museum in New England, located in 27 buildings in a historic mill complex in the Berkshires. Highlights include contemporary sculpture, visual, media & performing arts and concerts.

After an afternoon at Mass MoCA, explore the town of North Adams. Here you will find numerous art galleries as well as open studios. Check into The Porches Inn, a historic hotel in a block of late 19<sup>th</sup> Century row houses which meshes contemporary styles with a historical spirit, conveniently located within walking distance from Mass MoCA.

Enjoy Dinner at the Gala Restaurant, in nearby Williamstown. Known for a fusion of classic and contemporary cuisine the Gala Restaurant & Bar is located at The Orchards Hotel. Or, try dinner at The Williams Inn, also located in Williamstown.

### Day Three

Enjoy a complimentary continental breakfast at The Porches Inn before heading to South Deerfield, Mass, home of the Yankee Candle Village. Only an hour away, the store has over two million visitors a year, and offers over 160 scents to choose from in the Sampler Emporium. Tour the Candlemaking Museum and later experience Chandler's Restaurant at Yankee Candle Village, awarded "New England's Most Fulfilling Dining Experience" by *The New York Post*.



Travel 30 miles back to Springfield and explore the Town Square. Rest, relax and enjoy dinner at Virtuoso, featuring American, Italian and Asian influence cuisine, before a night at the symphony! Springfield's CityStage and Symphony Hall feature Broadway-style musicals, concerts and comedy shows year-round.

Check into Naomi's Inn, located in Springfield. Built in 1846, this historic inn combines quaint 18<sup>th</sup>-century character with modern 20<sup>th</sup>-century comforts.

### Day Four

After a leisurely breakfast, mesh old-world New England with modern New England by visiting the Holyoke Mall at Ingleside—a true American experience. Holyoke Mall is Western New England's largest shopping destination with 200 specialty shops, restaurants and department stores. Find your last minute gifts to bring home, before heading to the airport.

Arrive at Bradley International Airport at 3:45 p.m. and depart for Amsterdam Schiphol Airport at 5:45 p.m.
